John 17:22-23

We have seen that Abraham's call came after the scattering that took place at the tower of Babel. Here, God confused the language of the people so that they could not be unified in their selfish pursuit. (Gen 11:1-9) However, wherever there are people who assemble themselves for godly purposes, there will be blessing. (Gen 12:2-3).

Culture Check:

- When was the last time you examined your life to see if you were aligning yourself with godly purpose?
- How do you examine your life? Do you ask those around you how you are doing?
- How do you work with others in a unified effort to do good works? (Eph 2:10) Name specific involvements.
- Name some positive results of working with others.
- Do you feel more comfortable working with others in a particular task, project or ministry event or would you rather be with people in a Bible study, an accountability group or having people over to your house for fellowship?
- The last question has no right or wrong answer. It shows how you were formed to fulfill godly purposes. Write down one way you are going to align yourself with others to unify for His good purpose. (Phil 2:12-13)
- Finally, spend some time praying this prayer exactly as it is written for you, your family, your friends and your church community... (Eph 1:17-23)
